1) Do your homework

2) Make a list

Make a list of things you like and dislike. If mowing the lawn or weeding a flower garden isn't for you, make note of it. Do you prefer rocks vs. mulch? Do you love flowers, but dread replanting every year?

3) Make a budget

When budgeting for landscaping renovation, plan to invest about 10% of your home's value, according to the American Society of Landscape Architects (ASLA). A more elaborate backyard sanctuary may require 15 to 20%. Much of what you will spend depends on how long you plan to stay in your home. If you plan to stay for more than ten years, 15 to 20% will give you the enjoyment you desire for years to come.
